AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 116-5 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LONG BRANCH WHICH GOVERNS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BEACHES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 116-5 Z shall be amended as follows: (1) No person shall smoke any cigarettes, cigars, or other tobacco products, including chewing of tobacco on the beach or any beach area covered by this chapter at any time. (2) The penalty for violation of this Subsection Z (1) shall be a fine of \$100.00 for the first offense, \$200.00 for the second offense and \$300.00 for the third offense.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Director of the City of Long Branch as well as the Business Administrator of the City of Long Branch have determined that enforcement of such an Ordinance is more practical to enforce; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Director of the City of Long Branch as well as the Business Administrator recommend that Chapter 116-5 Subsection Z be amended to delete "specific designated areas for smoking".

WHEREAS, said Ordinance is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Long Branch.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other provisions of Chapter 116-5 shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the within amendment shall take effect after final passage and publication according to law.
